


TEKS-Aligned 31-Week Curriculum Guide (Grades 1–5)

Parent Accommodations Guide

How Children Learn Best

Students with learning differences benefit from explicit, systematic, multisensory instruction with frequent review.

Reading & ELAR Supports

Read aloud as needed, use audiobooks or text-to-speech, structured literacy, oral responses, reduced spelling load.

Writing Supports

Typing or dictation, reduced copying, graphic organizers, grading content separately from spelling/handwriting.

Math Supports

Read word problems aloud, use manipulatives, allow fact charts, break problems into steps.

Pacing & Workload

Extended time, shortened assignments, chunked lessons, regular review.

Organization & Attention

Visual schedules, checklists, quiet workspace, movement breaks.
